

## COVID-19 Attestation and Commitment to Conduct Daily Health Screenings

To maintain the health, safety and well-being of our students, staff, and community during the 2021-2022 school year, the South Kitsap School District requires this COVID-19 Attestation and Agreement be completed for all staff before attendance on campus or at school-based activities.

As the student listed on this form, I attest and agree that I will conduct the following health screening and attestation each day prior to arriving at school or engaging in any school activity located on or off South Kitsap School District property.

By reporting to school, I attest that the answer to each question below is **NO**. If I answer **YES** to any of the questions below, I agree to stay home from school and notify my parent/guardian to contact my school to excuse my absence, report why I did not pass my health screening and determine when I may return.

1. Have you experienced any of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours?

Fever (100.4 or higher) or chills	Recent loss of taste or smell	
Cough	Sore throat	
Fatigue	Congestion/runny nose	
Muscle or body aches	Nausea or vomiting	
Headache	Diarrhea (2 or more episodes in 24 hours)	
Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing	^not related to a medically documented chronic illness (i.e., asthma, migraine)	

- 2. Are you currently waiting on results of a COVID-19 test because you have experienced any symptom(s) listed above?
- 3. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days?

If you have **recovered** from a **COVID-19 infection in the last 90 days, skip question 4**, <u>otherwise continuing</u> reading and answer carefully:

4. In the last 14 days, have you been in close contact (6 feet or closer for 15 or more cumulative minutes during a 24-hour period) with anyone with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19?



Note: If you are **fully vaccinated\*** and answered yes to question 4, you may come to school if you do not have any of the symptoms listed above and will need <u>a COVID-19 test 3-5 days after your exposure</u>.

\*to be considered fully vaccinated, it must be at least 2 weeks since receiving the second dose in a two-dose series or 2 weeks since receiving a single dose vaccine

I understand that I cannot attend school or school related activities with any COVID-19 symptoms. If I develop symptoms while at school, I will immediately be isolated, my parent/guardian will be contacted, and I will need to leave campus. My parent/guardian will be required to work with the school to determine when I can return. I understand that COVID-19 guidance is subject to change and may be updated as new information is received by South Kitsap School District.
