Basketball Rules



Basketball is a team sport. Two teams of five players each maximum.

- 1. Supervisors are to make teams after player's line up on center court line. No more than five players on each team.
- 2. Game is to start with a jump ball.
- 3. No back court checking. You may not try to take the ball away from the other team before they cross the half-court line.
- 4. The teams will rotate taking the ball out for a throw in when a jump ball results from one player on each team having both hands on the ball at the same time.
- 5. Players may not travel with the ball, taking more than 2 steps without dribbling the ball. They may not double dribble, dribbling the ball with both hands at the same time or picking the ball up and then dribbling again.
- 6. When a team makes a basket they score 2 points.
- 7. Fouls include any type of physical contact.
 - Hitting
 - Pushing
 - Slapping
 - Holding
 - Charging-pushing or running over another player

If fouled while not shooting, the ball is given to the team the foul was committed upon.
